## Mercer Skating School – Inhouse Competition Solo Compulsory Event

This event can be open to skaters from Tots to Freestyle Level 5 and Adult levels. Skaters are grouped according to their age and test level. Skaters must compete with their highest level passed. Private lessons are not required to compete but are encouraged. Skaters are to perform only the three maneuvers in any order with a minimum of connecting steps. Each maneuver may be attempted one time. The skater will only be allowed to use ½ ice to perform their maneuvers. Additional maneuvers, such as any jumps, spin, pivot or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured <u>moves are not allowed</u>. Skaters should compete in the highest level passed by Session two or one level lower than their current level. Skaters are not allowed to skate up a level.
