Mercer Skating School - Compulsory Event

This event can be open to skaters from Tots to Freestyle Level 5 and Adult levels. Skaters are grouped according to their age and test level. Skaters must compete with their highest level passed. Skaters are to perform only the 3 maneuvers in any order with a minimum of connecting steps. Each maneuver may be attempted one time. The skater will only be allowed to use ½ ice to perform their maneuvers. Additional maneuvers, such as any jumps, spin, pivot or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured **moves are not allowed.** Skaters should compete in the highest level passed by Session two or one level lower than their current level. Skaters are not allowed to skate up a level.

ADDITIONAL COMPETITION NOTES FOR COMPETITORS

All skaters should arrive and check in at the registration desk **one hour** before there event. Males & females may be combined for some events. On-ice assistance is available for Tots only event. <u>Competitor test levels</u> – All competitor's test must be registered with ISI. The cost is \$5.00 per test and includes badge or badges for the test or tests registered. Cathy Adamoyurka the skating director will be able to register your ISI tests.

<u>Competition Start time</u> – The competition will start approximately between 1:30pm -2:00pm. Practice ice will be available before the start of the competition for an additional fee.
